THE UNIT UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT:

1. Acceptance of your \$250 secures your choice of session at camp for the number of Scouts and leaders indicated above. You need to advise camp of changes to this number as soon as you are aware of any.
2. The \$250 reservation fee will be held through the entire 2011 summer camp season. Following the 2011 camping season, the fee may be rolled over and applied as a deposit for the 2012 camp season (please indicate above if you plan to do so). The \$250 will be refunded to units not returning in 2012 by September 30, 2011. This fee is **NOT** refundable or transferable in the event of troop non-attendance.
3. A minimum of two qualified adult leaders, one of whom is at least 21 years of age, the second leader at least 18 years of age, will be in attendance with each troop at all times during the entire period that the troop is in camp.
4. While it is possible to request sharing a campsite with a specific troop, both units must so request and make their reservations at the same time. This does not absolve each unit of their responsibility to provide two-deep leadership. **Both units must submit a reservation form and the \$250 reservation fee.**
5. Campsite assignments will be based on a first come first served basis. While every attempt will be made to honor a unit's campsite preferences, the camp administration reserves the right to change a unit's campsite assignment prior to arrival at camp. Any required campsite changes occur only when necessary to ensure that every unit has an adequate number of tents. Two or more units may be assigned to the same campsite.
6. The following campsites have wood platforms & canvas tents (campsite capacity): Arrowhead (32), Diamond Hitch (32), Gunflint (22), Powderhorn (38). Doublebit (24).
7. Troops provide their own tents in the following campsites (campsite capacity): Buckskin (20), Musket (24), Sauk (36), Tomahawk A (24), Tomahawk B (24), Conestoga (34), Illini (32), Winnebago A (40), Winnebago B (32), Winnebago C (20), Kaskaskia (38).
